The Dixie Crow Chapter of the Association of Old Crows is hosting the 36<sup>th</sup> Annual Dixie Crow Symposium to raise money for local scholarship programs. The annual symposium benefits local students and has raised over \$615,000 for student scholarships in the Middle Georgia area. This year's theme is "*Electronic Warfare – Shaping America's Defense*".

The Hospitality Suite kicks off the week's events on Sunday evening in the Marriott Courtyard Hotel in Warner Robins. The golf tournament begins Monday morning at The Landings Golf Club and will be followed with a wonderful BBQ dinner. Our Symposium starts with the Plenary Session at 0800 Tuesday morning with the Exhibit Hall opening at 1100. The Dixie Crows will host the Exhibitor's Reception in the Century of Flight Hanger Tuesday evening and our annual banquet will take place Wednesday evening. Electronic Warfare short course and Program Management and Logistics short courses will be held Thursday in the Museum of Aviation Eagle Building.

#### **Security Clearances**

A US security clearance is required for all classified technical briefings and the EW Short courses. All personnel requesting access to classified presentations or the MSIC van must complete a visit request specifically for the Dixie Crow Symposium. The only exception is for **Government** employees carrying picture badges for Robins AFB Buildings 229 and 231. Briefings may be classified up to **SECRET**. Forward all visit requests via JPAS using SMO Code - RX1MFPTK6. If your company or organization does not have access to JPAS, mail a visit request to the Dixie Crow Chapter, P.O. # **Golf Tournament And Sports Dinner**

Golf awards will be presented after the second round at the Sports Banquet in the Landings Clubhouse. **Tickets for the Sports Banquet are \$15 and must be purchased separately.** From Robins Museum of Aviation, travel South on HWY 247 approximately 1.1 miles, turn left on Old Hawkinsville Road for 0.3 miles then left into Stathams Landing. The Golf Course is located on the left, approximately 1.2 miles

With the advent of sophisticated capabilities to provide awareness of the changes in the electromagnetic spectrum, the modern Warfighter has come to depend on advances in a wide range of Electronic Warfare to shape their capabilities. The technical sessions will provide an opportunity to hear about these advances from leaders in the field of Electronic Warfare. The sessions will be held in the Museum of Aviation Vista Scope Theater located in the Eagle Building beginning at 0800 on Tuesday and will run through 1630 on Wednesday. Some of the presentations may be classified up to **SECRET**. For specific information on the presentations, please refer to the Technical Session agenda available on the Dixie Crow website. The agenda will be available during the Symposium on signs located in the lobby and as a handout at the registration desk.

# **EW and Management Short Courses**

The EW and Management short courses will be offered Thursday from 0800 until 1700. The schedule will be available on the Dixie Crow website and posted in the Museum of Aviation. Presentations are subject to change. These courses are provided free of charge to registrants. Continuing Education Credit will be available to those Civil Service Employees who attend all sessions of either the Electronic Warfare courses or Management courses.

Electronic Warfare courses will be presented in the Museum of Aviation *Vista Scope Theater*. These informative presentations will focus on technical topics of interest in today's environment and may be classified up to **SECRET**. Management and Logistics courses will be offered in the Museum of Aviation Eagle Conference room (3<sup>rd</sup> floor). These courses will be unclassified and provide timely topics in program management and logistics.
